



**Ohio Hills Health Services is vaccinating patients and community members for COVID-19.  
Everyone welcome.**

**Who is eligible?** Any patient or community member who is age or group eligible. You do not need to be a patient of OHHS to be eligible for a COVID-19 vaccine. Currently, OHHS is offering the Moderna and Pfizer vaccines. The Moderna is available for those 18 years of age and over and the Pfizer is available to those 12 and over.

**How do I get the vaccine?** You must make an appointment by contacting OHHS at 740-239-6447.

**Can I walk-in for the vaccine?** No, you **MUST** make an appointment.

**What days and times will appointments be offered?** Hours will vary weekly based on vaccine availability. Some evening appointments are available.

Once I have my appointment, where do I go for the vaccine? Vaccines will be given at the Barnesville Family Health Center, 101 East Main Street, Barnesville, Ohio 43713

**What do I need to bring to the appointment?** You should bring a valid ID, Insurance Card and a mask if you have one.

**Will I be charged a fee for the visit/vaccine?** We will charge your insurance if available, but no one will be balanced billed for the visit or vaccine.

**What if I do not have health insurance?** Can I still get the shot? Yes, no one will be turned away due to insurance status.
